LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Dr. Sylvia A. Earle

Dr. Sylvia Earle - called "Her Deepness" by the New York Times and "Hero for the Planet" by Time Magazine - is an oceanographer, explorer and author. Dr. Earle set records going deep into the ocean in all manner of submersibles and broke barriers as the first female chief scientist at the National Atmospheric and Oceanic Administration. Dr. Earle's lifelong passion is marine ecosystems, with a focus on exploration, conservation and the development and use of new technologies for access and effective operations in the deep sea and other remote environments.

Dr. Earle and her foundation, Mission Blue, are focused on developing a global network of "Hope Spots" to safeguard the living systems that provide the underpinnings of global processes, from maintaining biodiversity and yielding basic life support services, to providing stability and resiliency in response to accelerating climate change.



INNOVATION IN TECHNOLOGY AWARD

Since 1992, President and CEO Liz Taylor and her team have grown Deep Ocean Exploration and Research (DOER) Marine, Inc. from a consulting and field services firm to a full-service engineering solutions company that is an industry leader in designing and building subsea robotic and manned systems for a variety of applications, ranging from deep ocean exploration to critical infrastructure inspection. DOER currently is focused on Project Deepsearch, an innovative endeavor to build a human-occupied submersible capable of full ocean depth, providing unlimited ocean access to science.



SEA AWARD - DR. DIVA AMON

Dr. Diva Amon

Dr. Diva Amon is a Trinidadian deep-sea biologist with a special interest in deep-sea organisms and how human activity affects life far below the ocean's surface. Dr. Amon has dedicated much of her time to exploring some of the deepest and most remote ocean habitats, from Antarctica to the Mariana Trench. She regularly ventures to the depths in submersibles, with her deepest dive to 1.6 miles below the ocean surface in the Cayman Trench in the Caribbean. She has discovered six new deep-sea species, including a lobster and two sponges. Dr. Amon is a strong voice on the need to effectively manage and protect the deep ocean from human impacts, including from mining, pollution and climate change.
